UP's present difficulties, we are going to crew these trains between Stockton

We don't see this as a perpetual operation, but rather one for the medium term while UP is still in a recovery stage. We do have arrangements in place for the Stockton – Roseville operation, and I would contemplate simply extending those same arrangements to cover a Stockton – Sparks operation.

I will be calling you next week to discuss this operation and to modify the existing arrangements or reach a new agreement to cover this operation.

Dear Mr. Young:

This letter will confirm our discussions about using Stockton conductors to run to Sparks, Nevada.

We have agreed on the following:

- 1. Presently, a pool at Stockton, supplemented by the Stockton extra board is used to handle trains to and from Roseville, California.
- 2. Due to the UP's current problems, BNSF has agreed to handle the Denver - Stockton trains between Stockton and Sparks.
- 3. The Stockton-Roseville pool, supplemented by the Stockton extra board will be used to protect this service.
